ANNUAL TOWN MEETING May 18, 2009

The Annual Town Meeting was held on Monday, May 18, 2009, in the gymnasium of the Deep River Elementary School. Approximately 30 citizens attended the meeting. First Selectman Richard Smith called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m. A motion to appoint Richard H. Smith, as moderator was made by Lori Guerette with second by Donald Routh. Motion carried.

The moderator appointed Town Clerk Jeanne Nickse as clerk of the meeting. The call was read. Item 2C of the call was amended to change the date from January 1, 2009 to January 1, 2010. A motion to accept the call of the meeting as amended was made by Lori Guerette with second by Donald Routh.

1. To approve the Town Budget for the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 in the amount of \$14,008,508.

This item has been removed from the call and sent to referendum vote by motion of the Board of Selectmen. The referendum will be held at the Deep River Library on Thursday, May 28, 2009, from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m.

2. To authorize the Tax Collector to collect real estate taxes and personal property taxes in two semi-annual installments, the dates to be July 1, 2009 and January 1, 2010.

A motion was made by Lori Guerette with second by John Larson to accept the above item. Motion carried.

To authorize the Tax Collector to collect regular motor vehicle taxes in one installment, due and payable on July 1, 2009.

A motion was made by Lori Guerette with second by John Larson to accept the above item. Motion carried

To authorize the Tax Collector to collect supplemental motor vehicle taxes in one installment, due and payable on January 1, 2010.

A motion was made by Lori Guerette to accept the above item as amended. John Larson seconded the motion. Motion carried

Any property tax due the Town of Deep River in an amount that does not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) shall be due and payable in a single installment on July 1, 2009.

A motion was made to accept the above item by Lori Guerette with second by Murray Zack. Motion carried.

3. To approve the five-year Capital Improvement Programs for 2009 through 2014.

A motion was made by Lori Guerette with second by John Larson to accept Item 3 of the call.

First Selectman Smith explained the Capitol Project Request line by line and answered any questions. There being no discussion a voice vote was taken and Item 3 was Approved.

A motion to adjourn was made by Lori Guerette, with second by Donald Routh. Meeting was adjourned at 8:20 p.m.
