



SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
August 27, 2013

A Special Town Meeting was held on Tuesday, August 27, 2013 in the Deep River Town Hall Conference room. Selectmen present were Dick Smith, Angus McDonald, and David Oliveria. Citizens in the audience included Karen Oliveria. There was no film crew present.

First Selectman Richard Smith called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. and appointed Angus McDonald as moderator. Angus appointed Amy Winchell as clerk of the meeting who then read the call. A motion to accept the call as read was made by David Oliveria with a second by Karen Oliveria. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to approve items #1- #5 was made by Karen Oliveria and seconded by David Oliveria.

DISCUSSION: David Oliveria asked what the bottom line was after amounts offset by additional revenues were factored in. Dick Smith explained the actual shortfall was about \$65,000 but we are expecting reimbursement from the State for the Village Street Bridge which will bring the amount down to almost nothing. He also spoke with Regional School District #4 Business Manager Garth Sawyer and was told the shortfall from the school budget would be offset by State reimbursements for Special Education costs and the Cafeteria Fund. The remaining shortfall for the school would be about \$7,500.

There being no further discussion, items #1 - #5 were **approved** unanimously.

A motion to adjourn was made by David Oliveria and seconded by Karen Oliveria. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:09 p.m.
