



REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT #4
BUDGET REFERENDUM
May 6, 2014

A budget referendum of electors and citizens qualified to vote at Town Meetings in the Town of Deep River was held at the Deep River Public Library, 150 Main Street, Deep River, on Tuesday, May 6, 2014, between the hours of 12 noon and 8 p.m. for the approval of the Regional School District #4 Budget in the amount of \$18,377,431 (eighteen million, three hundred seventy-seven thousand, four hundred thirty-one dollars) for the fiscal year July 1, 2014, to June 30, 2015. Poll voting was done by machine while absentee ballots were counted by hand. A total of 225 votes were cast including 8 absentee ballots. The total number of registered voters on the current list was 3,079. Voter turnout was 7%. Dale Winchell served as moderator.

Votes Cast: Yes- 69 No- 156

Budget was defeated in Deep River but passed in Chester and Essex. Total votes cast in district were 319 (yes) to 256 (no). Budget was passed by 63 votes.

Vote was sent to referendum by the Regional School District #4 Board of Education; no petition was circulated.
