



REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT #4
BUDGET REFERENDUM
May 3, 2016

A budget referendum of electors and citizens qualified to vote at Town Meetings in the Town of Deep River was held at the Deep River Public Library, 150 Main Street, Deep River, on Tuesday, May 3, 2016, between the hours of 12 noon and 8 p.m. for the approval of the Regional School District #4 Budget in the amount of \$19,480,374 (nineteen million, four hundred eighty thousand, three hundred seventy-four dollars) for the fiscal year July 1, 2016, to June 30, 2017. Poll voting was done by machine while absentee ballots were counted by hand. A total of 228 votes were counted including 4 absentee ballots. The total number of registered voters on the current list was 3,190. Voter turnout was 7%. Joanne Grabek served as moderator.

Votes Cast: Yes- 89 No- 139

Budget was defeated in Deep River but passed in Chester and Essex. Total votes cast in district were 290 (yes) to 220 (no). Budget was passed by 70 votes.

Vote was sent to referendum by the Regional School District #4 Board of Education; no petition was circulated.
