MacDonald stated the Town of Old Saybrook is exploring options for sanitary sewage disposal in the Chalker Beach area. Both Selectman are of the belief that this option may merit further discussion to determine its viability. MacKenzie requesting meeting with CT Deep to discuss this matter.

Financial Update:

Discussion of FY 18-19 budget focused mainly on capital items. Heating oil tank (30-year-old) removal / replacement cost may be significantly reduced if SCNG installs the proposed service to the Winter Avenue area, as the new boiler has the ability to be converted to natural gas. Cloverdale electrical upgrade will be completed as budgeted. The pickup truck replacement will be discussed after completion of the Cloverdale project.
