

Board of Health Minutes  
Meeting October 22, 2014

Present: Board of Health – Carolyn Shores Ness, David Wolfram, and: Mark Gilmore  
Interim Town Administrator – Kayce Warren

The meeting was called to order by Ms. Ness at 6:35 pm in the Town Hall at 8 Conway Street.

Ms. Ness said the purpose of this meeting was to render a decision regarding the Kinder Morgan proposed construction of a natural gas pipeline through the Town of Deerfield.

**She made a motion to deny Kinder Morgan the ability to operate any activities in our community. Any subsidiaries or affiliated companies will immediately cease from carrying on any activities in our Town. The motion was seconded by Mr. Wolfram.**

Following a brief discussion, **the Board voted unanimous approval of the motion.** Ms. Ness then read into the record a portion of the decision which is appended to these minutes.

A comment period followed. Tom Clark lead the way by thanking the Board for its work .Copies of the document will be forwarded to FERC and to Kinder Morgan. Attorney Cristobal suggested that if other towns wished to become involved that they first purchase a copy of the certified transcript. A meeting should then be convened to adopt a resolution to adopt Deerfield's decision. He commented Kinder Morgan made a mistake in not attending this evening's meeting. Ms. Ness affirmed the Board of Health's legal authority to make the decision presented at this meeting.

At this point the Board of Health concluded its business and returned to the Board of Selectmen's business.
