II. Chair Olszewski continues the public hearing on an application by Claudette Boudreau agent of Marian and Ted Chen, for a special permit, variance or whatever relief is needed to allow the property located at 43 Conway Street (Assessors Map 16, Parcel 136) which is now classified as a TWO-Family dwelling, and containing three (3) units, to be legally permitted a THREEfamily dwelling per section 2230 Use Regulations of Deerfield Zoning Bylaws.
