**Call to Order**

5:30pm: Selectman R. Andrew Robertson called the meeting to order.

**Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag**

Selectman R. Andrew Robertson asked all to rise and pledge allegiance to the Flag.

**Cindy McHugh – Elliot Hospital Agreement**

Cindy McHugh requested the Board of Selectmen sign the Elliot Hospital Medical Resource Hospital Agreement. This agreement will provide Deerfield Rescue with support, medication, and training and is the resource hospital. Also there is good communication between the Elliot Hospital and the Deerfield Rescue Squad.

**Serita Frey – Conservation Commission Land Purchase**

Serita Frey presented a Purchase and Sale Agreement to purchase land from Edythe H. Boisvert for a Conservation Easement. The 178 acres of land is on Dow Road will become a Town Forest. The property meets the criteria for making it a parcel of high conservation value. Ms. Frey asked the Board if they would sign the Purchase and Sales Agreement.

A Public hearing will be held on March 12, 2012 at 6:30 p.m.

**Chief Greeley – Cruiser Purchase**

Chief Greeley received 3 quotes for the purchase of a new cruiser.

Chief Greeley would like to go with Hillsboro Ford for the cruiser. The wait time for Erwin Ford is up to 14 weeks before delivery of the cruiser then another 5 to 6 weeks for 2-Way Communications to install the electronics.

With Hillsboro Ford it will be 2 weeks plus the 5 to 6 weeks for 2-Way Communications to install the electronics.
