#### **Unfinished Business:**

There was renewed discussion of the need to generate current figures for a Town Hall elevator warrant article or citizens petition for the 2016 town warrant. Dan Tripp has compiled good elevator cost figures, and he and Fran will check with Building Inspector Rick Pelletier on the availability of appropriate enclosure construction costs. \$124.00 was raised at the Old Home Day Root Beer Float booth for the Accessibility Fund, and there will be continued emphasis on exploring all possible funding sources for the project.

## **New Business:**

The Heritage Commission and Historical Society have been asked by the 2016 250th Committee to work together on a presentation of historical artifacts for the January opening reenactment ceremonies at the Town Hall. There was discussion of creating a bookmark type informational card to let people know what the Heritage Commission is all about. Hony, Carol and Fran will attend the next 250th meeting on December 16th for further input from the Committee. Lindsey and Mel will work on artwork and appropriate informational content. It was also mentioned that information should be available for where all the promotional 250th articles are available for purchase other than at specific fundraising events.
