

**HERITAGE COMMISSION MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by Hony Hoague at 7:00pm at the Library.

Review of Minutes:

The January 17th, 2017 Minutes were approved as written.

Review of Financials:

The Financial report for February 21, 2017 was presented as follows:

Budget figures are zeroed out until after Town Voting on March 14th

Heritage Fund - \$2343.11

Accessibility Fund - \$7661.09

Unfinished Business:

The Town Hall accessibility warrant article post card mailing is at the printers and expected to be ready to sort in bundles for the Post Office by early next week. It was decided that the Library would be the most convenient location for this process and any members available to help out will be notified of the date and time.

New Business:

Jeanne Menard provided information regarding ongoing work by the Division of Historic Resources (DHR) for presentation during the Northern Pass Site Evaluation Committee Hearings. Of particular interest for the Heritage Commission would be their recognition of specific areas of cultural importance, such as Deerfield Parade, which stand to be adversely impacted by the proposed project. DHR has been compiling information regarding Determination of Eligibility for the Parade area, as well as Meeting House Hill, as rural Historic Districts.

Other Business:

It was moved by Nancy Brown and unanimously seconded and approved by those present to request the Board of Selectmen to appoint Karen Leavitt to a three year term on the Heritage Commission. All present were most grateful that she is interested and willing to rejoin the Commission. Further appointments will be voted at our next meeting.
