5-Year Plan

- Joe presented an outline of a 5 year Capital Improvement Plan
- Commission reviewed the plan and added items to the plan
- Commission agreed to move forward with a number of items for the Spring and Summer (2013) such as: add playground structure at GBW; add storage shed; resurface tennis court and power wash basketball court; fix graffiti & replace mulch at Gazebo; JPD building repairs & improvements (Commission may plan a workday to help with this project).
- Hartford Brook fields need seeding and fertilization. Joe received a quote for this work but Commissions plans to hold off until the watering issue can be resolved (not prudent to seed/fertilize if we don't have a means to water the field)
- Other future projects include additional bleachers/benches for athletic fields; drainage work; electronic scoreboard; paving of parking lot; GBW interior work (painting and carpet replacement in hall); vehicle replacement plan

Joe Stone Trust Fund/Scholarship

- Money for this fund (\$1,797.21) has been moved into a separate account and will be available to distribute for scholarships as needed.
- Commission reviewed the applications for the scholarship to be awarded to a graduating high school senior. Unanimous decision to award two winners from Concord High School which will be presented to them on June 5th at the CHS Awards Night. Each scholarship will be for \$500.
- Julie was contacted by Leslie van Berkum regarding the 2014 Spring Coffeehouse fundraiser which is planned to benefit the Joe Stone Scholarship fund. She asked if we could switch to the 2013 Fall Coffeehouse. Commission agreed to move to the fall date (tentatively November 16th)
