Minutes of Public Meeting July 12, 2010

On June 28 at 7:30 the Derry Conservation Commission met in the NH Room of the Derry Municipal Center. The following members were present: Paul Dionne, Beverly Ferrante, Margaret Ives, Marianne Page, Richard Tripp, Dennis Wiley, Ric Buzzanga, Peg Kinsella, and Neil Wetherbee. Marianne Page sat for Jim Arruda and Richard Tripp sat for Paul Doolittle. Paul Doolittle arrived and Richard Tripp stepped down.

A motion was made by Paul Dionne, seconded by Marianne Page to accept the corrected minutes of June 28, 2010. Dennis Wiley and Peg Kinsella abstained, all others approved, motion carried.

Chair's Report:

M-R Wood Recycling – requested an extension beyond July 12th.

Lane Road – invoice from Richard Belmore for chipping on Lane Road during removal of invasives on Hannah Martin property. Beverly Ferrante to follow up to see if this is a duplicate billing.

State Department of Corrections – invoice for \$108.46 for three signs for Broadview Farms. Motion to approve payment by Paul Dionne, second by Paul Doolittle. Payment to be from administrative account. None abstained, all others approved, motion carried.

DES

Hood Pond – to DES from Mike Fowler about the status of Hood Pond. Information stating that no closures due to the presence of cyano bacteria and the total maximum load daily study for phosphorous.

8 North Shore Road – The property owner encouraged to retain a qualified environment consultant to determine compliance with RSA 482-A and delineate jurisdictional areas on the property.

246 Island Pond Road – Provencal 1 Family Trust filing a petition of appeal to DES ruling that they have done activities in jurisdictional wetlands.

10 Tsienneto Road (CLM) – permit description reduces the impact from 1100 to 580 square feet for the construction of bridge footings and bridge for access to parking area.

David Preece – requests comments on Piscataquog River Watershed Plan.

Site Reviews:

10 Tsienneto Road (tax map/lot 08079) – Keith Coviello of Sublime Consultants. No new wetland permit, amended to reduce impact from 1100 to 580 square feet. Site walk conducted. There is no wetland setback required for pavement. One parking space was removed due to its proximity to wetland and removed curbing from plan at the rear of the parking lot. Net increase is fifty-one (51) new parking spots. It was also noted during the site walk that numerous exotic invasives are present and need to be controlled/removed.

Conservation Activity:

Easement Monitoring – yet to happen. Dennis Wiley will let everyone know when this will occur.

Shephard Park – boundary marking in process.

Broadview Farm – overnight parking sign installed and stolen on first night. No report on tent platforms.

Cole Marsh – site walk on July 17 at 8 AM. Meet on Damren Road (Francis Courmier Trail).

Go Green Committee – Dennis Wiley said the committee is active again and will have booth/presence at Derryfest.

Other Business:

Received call from property owner about the amount of bitter sweet on his property. Doug Cygan, state department of agriculture, is point of contact.

Derry Farmer's Market – Beverly Ferrante reported farmer's market is very successful and that it will be open rain or shine.

Non-Public Meeting:

Motion by Paul Dionne, second by Beverly Ferrante, to go into non-public meeting pursuant to RSA 91-A:3 (d). Members voting aye: Ric Buzzanga, Denis Wiley, Beverly Ferrante, Paul Dionne, Margie Ives, Marianne Page, and Paul Doolittle. Members voting nay: none. Motion passed. Motion by Paul Dionne to invite Town Council representative Neil Wetherbee to non-public, second by Paul Doolittle. None abstained, all others approved, motion carried.
