Gus Cocozza Reduce Speed from 30mph to 20mph Fairway s

Alan explained the traffic study results to the Committee and Mr. Cocozza. He also stated that the results of the study were passed along to the Police Department. The Police Department will use the information to tailor when they are patrolling the area.

Mr. Cocozza agrees with the findings and hopes that the recent newspaper article and additional police enforcement will make the residents and visitors more aware of their speeds. The word is getting around in the Community.

Alan Cote stated that the traffic counts give pretty reliable results because motorists are not aware of the traffic counter. The results of the traffic count identify when the motorist are speeding. He stated that overall 43% of the traffic is traveling 20-25 mph in the community based on the report.

Al Dimmock stated that there are a few speeders during the middle of the night around 2 - 3 am in the morning.

Mr. Cocozza thanked the Committee for looking into their concern.
