## Jane Simard – Request for a blinking light at South Range School

Jane Simard stated that she had received a request to install a blinking light at South Range School along the Silver Street side of the school. She stated that does not feel that the area would warrant a blinking light in that location, but wanted to bring the request forward for discussion.

Mike Fowler stated that the Highway Division would not endorse installing a blinking light there because the speeds would not support a light in that area.

Ed Garone asked if there was proper school signage on Silver Street.

Mike Fowler stated that he would have the Highway Division verify that the appropriate signage has been posted.

Additional Note: Mike Fowler had Alan Cote take a look at the signage on Silver St.

Alan Cote stated that there are S1-1 signs located on Silver Street coming from Dustin Ave as well as Bradford St, Briarwood St, Muzzey Ln, and Claire Ave. Traffic in Silver St is repetitive traffic and motorist in this area are well aware of the schools existence. Putting up a flashing light is not warranted at this location.

# Mike Fowler - Public Info. Meeting - NHDOT - Rt28/Windham Depot Rd/Kilrea Rd

NHDOT will be holding a Public Informational Meeting on April 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm at the Municipal Center to discuss the Rt28/Windham Depot Rd/Kilrea Rd intersection improvements. Conceptual plans have been drafted and they include a full signalized light to be installed at the intersection as the Highway Safety Committee wanted. The State plans to go out for Bid late 2011 and begin construction in 2012.

Jane Simard asked if the Builder would still be contributing funds to the project.

Mike Fowler stated that the plans have not been finalized to determine the actual cost of the project, but that he would know more after the public informational meeting and the plans are finalized.

Ed Garone asked if they were going to be taking the house in question.

Mike stated that it doesn't look like they are going to have to.

Ed Garone asked if the light would have a longer standing RED light buffer to allow motorists to settle before the next light turns green.

Mike Fowler stated that he was not sure of the proposed signal phase timing, but would mention to the State that the Highway Safety Committee would like them to consider a longer standing RED light.
