Motion by: Councilor Wetherbee to add to the Human Services \$30,000 in item #110 È, seconded by Councilor Benson. (Chairman Metts - upon referencing the minutes of the meeting of 5/14/2009 the motion was disallowed)

Councilor Coyle read an email he had sent to the other Town Councilors asking there be no changes to the budget or to inform all beforehand.

Councilor Coyle raised a Charter Objection.

Motion by: Councilor Benson to add to the Transfer Station \$10,000 in item #140 OT, seconded by Councilor Wetherbee. Vote: 3-4-0 (Coyle, Chirichiello, Fairbanks, and Carney) Failed

Councilor Benson wished to discuss the MEO II Wastewater Position.

Councilor Benson moved to go into Non Public under RSA 91-A: 3 II (a) seconded by Councilor Wetherbee Vote: 5-1-1 (Coyle) (Fairbanks)

Motion by: Councilor Benson to add \$166,750 as one half year interest on the TIF-Rte28 District, seconded by Councilor Wetherbee. Vote: 3-4-0 (Chirichiello, Wetherbee, Carney, and Fairbanks) *Failed*

Town Council had discussion on their disagreement for not wanting to appropriate funds at this time or to this specific project. A supplemental appropriation could be made at a later time with a 5-2 vote. Town Council decided they would have a discussion on Economic Development later in 2009.
