- 1. Meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM.

- 3. Carol, Margaret, & Alan reported on their field trip to Carlisle. They agreed that of the 3 sites visited, the one on School Street in the center of Carlisle was by far the most applicable to Dunstable/the "Best Triangle". (3 colonial style buildings, 6 rental units per building, senior housing)
- 4. Carol & Margaret have been attending town housing coordinators meetings, & will continue to do so. Very useful. They reported on a "Challenge Grant Community Innovation" opportunity, where we could join other towns in the application process. Elizabeth Barnett (Carlisle) would prepare the application for the towns to prepare a "Resource Guide" for each town re water, septic, etc. available for public housing. Carol & Margaret will seek support of the selectmen to join this process.
- 5. Carol reported that the Planning Board will hold a public hearing on 9/15/14 at 7:40 PM (lower Town hall) on the AHC's requests for changes in the Zoning By-law regarding "in-law" apartments and the acreage required for a senior housing development. A special Town meeting on 10/20/14 will includes these items.
- 6. The Best Triangle project feasibility study

Dana: Should we consult with other towns to get an idea of rough cost for study? Madonna can help with RFP

Alan: We need to coordinate with Water Board & their upgrade plans, & with the Dumont Land Committee.

All agreed that we should start with Best Triangle: it is simpler than MUD, addresses a clear need, and we have a model (Carlisle) we like.

Mary: but don't forget the MUD "disaster scenario"; all agreed!
