

Board of Health Minutes
June 20, 2017

The meeting opened at 7:00 p.m. with Ms. Moeller and Ms. Amodei present. Mr. Parkin was absent.

The minutes of the meeting of June 6th were approved as written.

All bills and time sheets submitted were approved for payment.

Trash & Recycling

The Board continued to discuss alternatives to dropping off trash and recycling at the transfer station.

The curbside contractor could use our bulky item fee list for charging the resident for the pickup of bulky items.

The sale of roll-offs at the transfer station was also discussed. Ms. Moeller will go to the transfer station to take pictures of the equipment.

The Board understands that we must use 32 gallon trash containers for the collection for all residents. If they want a second one; they would have to pay for it.

Larger containers for recycling can be provided; possibly 64 or 90 gallons per the grant.

Ms. Amodei will contact Irene Congdon and our Town Administrator Tracey Hutton to discuss what the best way is to begin the process of bidding.

Pesticides

Ms. Moeller began researching the requirements of spraying of pesticides on town property. She is working on a memo to be sent to all pertinent town departments about it.

34 Maple Street- Lot 3

The Board signed a building permit application for the above after confirming that the water test report met all requirements except arsenic. A filtering system will be required for occupancy. They also confirmed by reviewing the building plans that 4 bedrooms are proposed. The septic plan is approved for 4 bedrooms.

Lot 10 Alexander Way

A plan for a conventional system was approved in 2015 for the above. The new plan submitted is designed using infiltrators. The Board approved the new plan. The water test report met all requirements except arsenic. A filtering system will be required for occupancy.

626 Groton Street – Lot 3

The Board reviewed a septic plan for the above and approved it. This plan was previously approved but expired. The water test report met all requirements except arsenic. A filtering system will be required for occupancy.
