Present: Selectman Kenneth J. Leva and newly elected Selectman Daniel F. Devlin; Selectman Walter F. Alterisio absent.

The meeting was called to order at 7:05PM with quorum present. The members present initially planned to vote to postpone action on a number of items due to unexpected illness of Selectmen Walter Alterisio, which prevented his attendance at this meeting, and to take care of only the items they were comfortable with and to postpone action on the other items to be itemized in the posting for continued session tomorrow evening at 7:00PM, the primary item being the election of offices and rescheduling of discussion with Town Clerk re: access to Town Counsel. However, after looking at the items which needed to be addressed, the board determined they could handle all but those two items and would schedule for the beginning of next week.

The board approved the Dunstable Congregational Church's request for use of the bandstand/gazebo on June 12th for their 9:30AM worship service after motion by Selectman Devlin and approval by both members; request from Jordan Quigley for use of bandstand/gazebo and town common area for wedding rehearsal on Friday, July 2nd and wedding ceremony on Saturday, July 3rd was discussed and the board approved requiring police detail for the service, noting it is somewhat more involved, including installation of tents, etc., more than most uses of the common.

The board also approved the request for the banner for summer concert series after motion by Selectman Devlin, 2nd and vote with both he and Selectman Leva in favor.

The board decided to reschedule their meeting for Tuesday, May 31st either at 9AM prior to police negotiations session or immediately after negotiations session with 1st item on their agenda being the election of officers and reorganization of the board. Secretary will confirm availability and preference of members and post accordingly.

Treasurer's warrants were reviewed and signed and the meeting adjourned at 7:45PM after appropriate motion and vote.
