## **Conservation Commission Minutes** **September 14, 2009**

### **Meeting Minutes**

### **Bills**

### **Hardy Street Property (Carter) Grant**

No word from the state regarding the grant for the Hardy Street (Carter) property. Alan explained that the Commission received an e-mail from Irene Delbono regarding changes to the draft Conservation Restriction. Alan and Rich Larkin will work on this with Ms. Delbono.

### **130 Hardy Street – Blackburn Property**

The certified mail was never picked up so the Secretary mailed (regular mail) a copy of the Enforcement Order to Mr. Blackburn. Leah will stop by the property to check on the restoration.

### **Open Space and Recreation Plan**

The Secretary reminded the Commission that the Open Space and Recreation plan will expire in December of 2010. Leah will start working on the changes to the plan. Commission members asked for copies so they too could review the plan.

### **Melancon – High Street**

It was noticed that the piles of sand/dirt at the Melancon property on High Street were spread out around the ditch and not removed as had been requested.

### **Farnsworth Timber Cut**

Alan reported that he will meet Gary Gouldrup and the forester from Fish & Game to view the site from which the Farnsworth timber will be removed through.

The Commission received notification from the state requesting that harvesting be limited to November 1<sup>st</sup> through March 31<sup>st</sup> to limit impact to the wood turtle and its habitat.
