Conservation Commission Minutes January 9, 2012

Meeting was called to order at 7:31pm by member, Alan Chaney Members present: Bill Moeller, Jeff Haight, Marilyn Pike and Judy Larter Members absent: Leah Basbanes and Juan Amodei Meeting held: At the Dunstable Town Hall – lower level – Grange Room

<u>Eagle Scout Project – Collin Sullivan</u>

Boy Scout, Collin Sullivan, attended the meeting with his advisor to discuss an Eagle Scout project on Blanchard Hill. Collin is proposing to install water bars on the east side of Blanchard Hill. These water bars will help slow down erosion and make hiking easier. When it was brought up about the number of water bars that the project entails, Collin stated that it depended upon the steepness of the trail and how far apart he has to put the water bars. The Commission agreed that he could use pressure treated wood or downed oak/maple trees, however, no concrete or steel materials. Ditches will be dug on the side of the trail and filled with some gravel to provide for adequate drainage. When asked about how he was planning on anchoring the water bars, Collin said that they will be anchored, however, he needs to research this 1a bit further. After the discussion, the Commission told Collin that they will support his project. Collin will return to the Commission when he is ready to begin the project.
