Conservation Commission Minutes Monday, April 23, 2013

Meeting was called to order at 6:35pm by member Alan Chaney Members present: Bill Moeller, Marilyn Pike and Judy Larter Members absent: Juan Amodei, Jeff Haight and Leah Basbanes

Meeting held: At the Dunstable Town Hall– 511 Main Street-lower level– Grange Room

<u>Dick Henry - Question on Road Way Access to Amos Kendall</u>

Mr. Henry told the Commission that he was in attendance representing Kathleen Henry who is the property owner of 11 acres adjacent to the Amos Kendall Conservation Area on High Street. He went on to say that plans are underway to forest her property, tying it in with Bob Kennedy's cutting operation. Both parties are working with Dan Cyr and the hope is to start the process in May. Mr. Henry told members that Mr. Cyr mentioned that there is enough timber to cut on the Commission's 25 acre parcel if we are interested. Alan said that he will need to review the deed and run this by Town Counsel. At the March 11th meeting, Bob Kennedy asked and received permission to haul his timber out of the Amos Kendall road. Mr. Henry came to ask for the same permission. Alan said that if Mr. Henry's request is granted, it would be on trust; therefore, no bond or contract would be required. Bill made a motion to allow logging access to Mr. Henry for the Amos Kendall Conservation Area. Judy 2nd the motion. Alan asked to amend the motion to include "subject to the recommendations of Town Counsel". Judy 2nd the amendment. Motion with amendment passed unanimously. The Commission will go out to the site this Saturday, April 27th to view the area.
