Additional Information Paving Common Drive - 430 Groton Street – Jim Keough Mr. Keough e-mailed the office earlier in the day asking to postpone his appointment until the next meeting. The Secretary put him on the June 10th agenda at 7:30pm.

Meeting Minutes - May 15, 2013

Judy made a motion to approve the meeting minutes, as submitted, from the May 15th meeting. Juan 2nd the motion. – Motion passed unanimously.

Alan later asked to reopen the topic of the meeting minutes by making a change to the 2nd page "Tobey Request for Determination" adding "*of the Board of Directors*" in front of the words Dunstable Rural Land Trust. Bill made a motion to accept the correction as noted. Judy 2nd the motion. – Motion passed unanimously.

Review and/or Sign Bills

Judy made a motion to sign the invoices for \$55.88 for the City of Nashua taxes (July 1st invoice) and \$7.63 for certified mail. Bill 2nd the motion. –Motion passed unanimously.

ANRAD Hearing - Hall Street/Lake Street - Carolina Properties, LLC - 7:45pm

George Dimakarakos (Stamski and McNary, Inc.) and Gerard Welch from Carolina Properties, LLC were in attendance as well as resident, Jim Regan. Leah opened the hearing for the Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation at 7:47pm.



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Mr. Dimakarakos told members that there is one clearly defined isolated wetland on the property. A Bordering Vegetated Wetland is located on an adjoining town owned lot. The Commission felt that since they are very familiar with this property there was no need for a site visit. Although it did not have any bearing on the hearing, members reviewed the current two options before the Planning Board; a traditional preliminary plan and an open space plan, both with twelve lots. Mr. Regan asked Mr. Welch if there are plans to remove the trash around the wetland. Mr. Welch indicated that he does plan on cleaning up the area during construction of the subdivision. Leah said that depending upon which plan is ultimately approved and how Mr. Welch plans on removing the trash, he may or may not need to come before the Commission again. Alan made a motion to close the hearing and accept the delineation as submitted on the following plan: Resource Area Delineation Plan in Dunstable, Massachusetts, for Carolina Properties LLC, May 9, 2013 by Stamski and McNary, Inc. Bill 2nd the motion. – Motion passed unanimously.

<u>Order of Conditions – Lake Drawdown and Weed Control – Lake Massapoag Rod & Gun Club/Dunstable Conservation Commission</u>

The Order of Conditions for the lake drawdown and weed control for the Lake Massapoag Rod and Gun Club was written. Bill made a motion to accept the OOC as outlined at tonight's meeting. Marilyn 2nd the motion. – Motion passed unanimously.

Additional Topics Discussed Not Noted on the Agenda

Chair for Fiscal Year 2014

Judy made a motion for Leah to remain Chair for fiscal year 2014. Bill 2nd the motion. – Motion passed unanimously with Leah abstaining from the vote.

<u>61 Valley Street – Brenda Carter – Enforcement Order</u>

The Secretary told members that she had received the decision of the Board of Appeals for 61 Valley Street. The Board denied the appeal and ordered the immediate cessation of activities (construction and landscaping business) on the property. The Commission asked the Secretary to remind Ms. Carter that she has until June 15th to abide by their request to clean up the property.

E-Mail Regarding Town Cleanup

The Commission received an e-mail from Stephen Spaziani from Nashua regarding cleaning up some of the Conservation areas in town. The Commission asked the



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Secretary to contact Charlie Tully since one of the areas mentioned falls on his property. They will discuss this at the next meeting and then contact Mr. Spaziani.

Motion made to adjourn at 8:16pm. Motion 2nd. - Motion passed unanimously. The next meeting of the Dunstable Conservation Commission is scheduled for Monday, June 10, 2013, 7:30pm at the Dunstable Town Hall.
