Minutes of June 24, 2014

The Conservation Commission met on Tuesday, June 24, 2014 at 7:00 PM in the Mural Room at the Duxbury Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Joe Messina at 7:03 PM.

PUBLIC MEETING, FITZGERALD, 247 GURNET ROAD, SECOND FLOOR ADDITION, 7:05 PM

There was no representative of the project present. A neighbor, Lawrence Dullea, of 6 East Pine Road, was present to express his concerns about a fence on the property because he was told it can only be addressed when there is an application pending. Mr. Dullea brought some photographs that he asked to have distributed to the Commission; he additionally requested an email he sent to Joe Grady be distributed to the Commission. Without a representative from the project present, the Commission decided to continue the matter to the next meeting.

On a motion by Sam Butcher, seconded by Barbara Kelley, it was unanimously voted to continue the Public Meeting for 247 Gurnet to July 15, 2014 at 7:10 PM.

CONTINUANCE OF PUBLIC HEARING, NOONE, 81 GURNET ROAD, REMOVE EXISTING CONCRETE DRIVEWAY AND REPLACE WITH POROUS PAVERS, 7:10PM SE18 – 1669

At 7:10 PM, the Committee reviewed the revised plan submitted by the applicant for this project. The reconfigured driveway coverage does not exceed the 1382 square feet that is allowed based on the existing driveway, and therefore the square footage now meets the requirements as defined by the Commission.

On a motion by Tom Gill, seconded by Barbara Kelley, it was unanimously voted to write Orders of Conditions for SE 18-1669.

PUBLIC HEARING, DOYLE, 12 SOULE AVE, SEPTIC SYSTEM AND GRADING, 7:15 PM SE18-1673

At 7:19 pm, Freeman Boynton, representing Steven Doyle, described the project which is to construct a septic system and perform necessary grading and landscaping. The Board of Health has approved the septic plan, it meets all setbacks and requirements. Sam Butcher asked if the regarding at the site will be minor and Mr. Boynton confirmed it would be minor.

On a motion by Tom Gill, seconded by Barbara Kelley, it was unanimously voted 5-0-0 to write Orders of Conditions for SE18-1673.

PUBLIC HEARING, KING CAESAR BEACH TRUST, 0 KING CAESAR ROAD, REPAIR GROINS AND BEACH NOURISHEMENT SE18-1674

Freeman Boynton, representing the applicants, King Caesar Beach Trust, presented the project. This project is to try to restore the beach to its previous condition before a stone wall was incorrectly located about 25 years ago. The groins are pre-existing and pre-dated the seawall. The groins will be repaired and some similar grain material trucked in to the beach. During this process the property line issue will be remedied.

On a motion by Tom Gill, seconded by Sam Butcher, it was unanimously voted 5-0-0 to write Orders of Conditions for SE 18-1674.

ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS:

Minutes: On a motion by Sam Butcher, seconded by Barbara Kelley, the minutes of June 3, 2014 were approved by a vote of 4-0-1 with Joe Messina abstaining.

Vose Conservation Restriction:

Pat Loring did a presentation to the Committee about this Conservation Restriction. This is a small piece of land that is historically significant because of its association with Rachel Carson. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts is very supportive of the restriction and suggested removing the house, driveway, and garage from the area with the restriction, leaving 0.5 acres. The Conservation Commission is being asked to hold the restriction which would be Conservation Restriction #37 for Duxbury.

Tom Gill asked why the house, driveway, and garage are not part of the area under the restriction, and Pat Loring explained that in case the house or septic needs repairs, it is easier to get these repairs addressed if the house is outside of the restricted area. The house is currently rented with the tenant amenable to providing public access. Sam Butcher said he saw nothing of concern to the Conservation Commission in the restriction; Pat Loring reported that Joe Grady is also in support of the Conservation Commission holding this restriction.

On a motion by Tom Gill, seconded by Sam Butcher, it was unanimously voted 5-0-0 to accept the Conservation Restriction on the Vose property on Powder Point.
