BOARD OF SELECTMEN MINUTES

<u>Present</u>: Shawn Dahlen, Chair; Elizabeth Sullivan, Vice-Chair, and Christopher Donato, Clerk.

Absent: No members were absent.

The meeting was opened at 7:00 PM

OPEN FORUM

Mr. Steven Peterson, a resident of Bolas Road, asked to be recognized. He said that he had tried to bring up the issue of the North Hill Golf Course management in the past, but was not allowed to speak because the matter was in litigation. He said that, at the time he was refused the opportunity to speak, the Town's exposure was in the range of \$40 - \$80K. He said that the Town's current liability is approximately \$1.2 million.

Mr. Peterson said that furthermore, the matter of North Hill Golf Course management was discussed in Open Session at a later date, but that he was also not allowed to speak on that occasion. Mr. Dahlen explained that the Open Session discussion was different. During the Open Session, the Selectmen were holding a hearing on whether Johnson Golf was in violation of their existing management contract. They were only taking testimony from the Town's management and Johnson Golf Management. The matter in litigation, which cannot be discussed in public, has to do with a different aspect of the situation.

Mr. Peterson said that the court issued a decision last week, which the residents should know about. Mr. Dahlen and Ms. Sullivan said that Mr. Peterson was trying to discuss a matter of litigation, and that this could hurt the Town's position. Mr. Donato disagreed. He said that the court decision is a public document. Against the wishes of Mr. Dahlen and Ms. Sullivan, Mr. Donato insisted on reading from the court decision.

At that point, Mr. Dahlen ended the discussion.

Mr. Dahlen recused himself from the discussion and vote on this license, because he is a Director of the Duxbury Bay Maritime School.
