- 4. Long discussion on the next direction of the AEC, which could be recommending in time of electric outages, batteries to assist in a number of priority locations (to be selected). Some of the obvious ones are the Police, Fire Departments, DPW, Senior Center, portions of the schools (shelter and kitchen and pumps), others: fuel supply, water works. A key note is that there are grants available for "resiliency" which could view capacities, demand and capacity response, grid resilience.
