

## **DUXBURY HISTORICAL COMMISSION**

**Minutes: October 2, 2013**

**Present:** members Robert C. (Terry) Vose, R. Tag Carpenter, Lee Adams, Leslie Lawrence, and Robb D'Ambruoso, constituting a quorum.

*Note: numbering below is chronological, and does not correspond to agenda-item numbering.*

1. Mr. Vose called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m.
2. Arthur Evans, candidate for the Commission, was interviewed. Resident of Ashdod, and retired from a career in publishing. After Mr. Evans left the meeting the Commission discussed his candidacy. Mr. Carpenter moved to recommend his candidacy to the Board of Selectmen; the motion was seconded and unanimously approved.
3. Discussion of Community Preservation Committee Article for 2014 Town Meeting. Mr. Carpenter moved to have the Commission prepare and submit a request for a \$50,000.00 allocation to the Commission, to be applied over fiscal years 2015, 2016 and 2017 toward finishing the registration with the Federal government of national historic districts in Duxbury, including Shipbuilders, Cove Street, Mayflower Cemetery, Town Hall and First Parish Church, and High Street; the motion was seconded and unanimously approved.
4. Duxbury Online Historical Archives Project. Mr. Carpenter moved to have the Commission sponsor an article for the 2014 Town Meeting on behalf of the online Archives committee requesting funding in the amount of \$2,500 from the Community Preservation Committee to purchase new hardware and cover additional operating expenses.

*T. Carpenter left the meeting at 7:00 p.m.; a quorum remained.*

5. The meeting was adjourned upon a motion, seconded and unanimously approved, at 7:04 p.m.
