

DUXBURY HISTORICAL COMMISSION

Minutes: October 10, 2012

Present: Leslie Lawrence, Lee Adams, Terry Vose, Laura Doherty, and Tag Carpenter,

Andy Wiemeyer attended as a guest until he is voted in by the board of selectmen

Under open forum, discussed ideas for planning grants for the Myles Standish cellar hole. Welcomed Andy Wiemeyer as prospective new member. Briefly discussed plans for letter from commission regarding proposed dock at 685 Washington Street and the need for additional information. This will be on the agenda for the next meeting.

Accepted with regret the resignation of Lois McKeown.

Agreed to ask Anne Murray whether it would be possible to place an article in the Clipper regarding the opening on the commission. Will follow up on one potential candidate, David Utti.

Voted to accept the minutes of September 6 with the following change which is in italics – vote to approve Terry’s appointment to the CPC was moved by Lee, seconded by Leslie, unanimous. Moved by Lee, seconded by Tag, unanimous. Voted to accept the minutes of September 12. Moved by Leslie, seconded by Tag, unanimous.

Voted to approve the demolition application for 29 Duck Hill Road to replace the existing one car garage with a two car garage plus playroom, above. Moved by Tag, seconded by Terry, unanimous.

Discussed 267 Winter Street, location of historic carpenter shop and the need to preserve it. The school will not be involved – should it be moved but in order to do so the trustees would have to approve this and also any application for CPC funding.

The date for “Claiming a Deed” reception will be November 8 from 4:30 until 6:30 p.m. at the Plymouth Registry of Deeds. This is the commission’s contribution to the town’s 375th celebration.

Only about half of the property owners have granted permission for property access for the historic properties survey. This will be followed up.

The campaign against the CPC reduction will be strengthened with signs place in front of CPC preserved properties and articles in the newspaper.

The process and application form for Demolition Delay needs to be addressed and will be followed up. The next meeting will be November 15 at 7:00 p.m.
