Open Forum: discussed plans by T-Mobile, New England to erect cell tower in Duxbury pertaining to which we sent a letter containing our concerns. Company has since erected a balloon close to 200 feet above ground and viewed from different locations and historic areas. They maintained and offered photos attesting it was not visible.

No new Requests for Demolition Applications have been submitted to Inspectional Services.

180 High Street is still being discussed. There is no news regarding 24 Standish Street.

Members are to think about properties to be included in next Survey of Historical Properties. Question was asked why Native American sites can't be included. Terry will follow up with Lynne Devnew on compiling past surveys into one document.

Voted to allow the complete demolition of the shed/garage at 105 Washington Street as requested in the Application for Demolition Permit, January 17, 2011. Missing photos have now been submitted.

Offered suggestions to Leslie regarding Duxbury History she is compiling for phone book. Members appreciate the work she has done.

More citizen education is planned for town meeting article regarding the formation of Local Historic District.

There is a delay on the 685 Washington Street project because the application to the Army Corps of Engineers was not right.
