Minutes: March 24, 2010

Voted:

Unanimously to allow demolition/alterations at 1070 Tremont Street involving the removal of two windows, further back from the street before the ell, on the driveway side as stated in the application dated March 12. This decision was made at the commission's meeting immediately following a site visit by members.

Unanimously to approve minutes of February 24.

Discussed:

Short application for structure demolition permit at 98 Surplus Street. Commission noted that copies of deeds dating back to when structures first appeared were not included. Members will reconsider this application at their next meeting pending inclusion of this information.

Norman reported that Wendy Frontiero has submitted a draft of her survey of 29 properties (one is not entirely complete) and a bill for one half of her total fee according to her agreement. Information is needed on the size of Tree of Knowledge corner and the types of trees at that location. Members of the Unitarian Church will be trying to determine the location of their first meeting house at the Alden Cemetery.

Database of historical houses will be corrected and updated by Norman and Lynne for choosing properties for the next survey, once information is received from Barbara.

Agreed to post site visits so that decisions regarding whether to request a short or long form can be made provided there is a quorum present according to regulations or, if not a quorum at the site visit, at the next meeting.

Next meeting is scheduled for April 6 at 7 PM.
