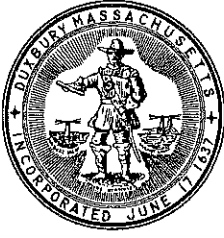

Executive Session Minutes 11/13/14

The Planning Board met in an emergency joint meeting with the Board of Selectmen and Zoning Board of Appeals on Monday, November 13, 2014 at 7:00 PM at the Duxbury Town Hall, 878 Tremont Street, Mural Room.

VOTE TO ENTER EXECUTIVE SESSION
