### <u>OPPORTUNITY FOR RESIDENTS TO ADDRESS THE COUNCIL ON AGENDA ITEMS</u>

Janet Facer, 36 Chapman Street, President of the Women's 9 Hole Golf League, supports

most of the Mayor's recommendations for the East Hartford golf course, but does not agree with closing the downstairs of the clubhouse to the public.

Susan Kniep, 44-46 and 50 Olde Roberts Street, raised several questions on the East Hartford golf course lease agreement: (1) were drainage upgrades made to the course as stated in the agreement; (2) did MDM Golf LLC post performance bonds and are those bonds up-to-date; and (3) did MDM Golf LLC submit annual audits to the town.

Mary Martin, member of the East Hartford Rotary Club, and Sheryl O'Connor, current President of the East Hartford Rotary Club, spoke in support of the purchase of a new Sprinter Van as a bookmobile for the East Hartford Public Library, made possible with a donation by the East Hartford Rotary Club.

Mayor Leclerc (1) thanked Linda Carrasquillo for her service to the town by serving, for many years, on the Patriotic and Veterans Affairs Commissions; (2) thanked the Golf Course Task Force Committee for their efforts and recommendations made for the East Hartford golf course; (3) supports the following agenda items: (a) the purchase of a new Sprinter Van to be used as a bookmobile for the East Hartford Public Libraries; (b) the C-Pace resolution; and (c) the bid waiver for the purchase of a used pumper for the East Hartford Fire Department.

Chair Kehoe granted Ram Aberasturia a point of personal privilege to recognize the death of David A. Walls, former Principal of Silver Lane Elementary School, who passed away on March 9, 2013. ### Recommendations re: East Hartford Golf Course

MOTION

By Barbara Rossi seconded by Marc Weinberg to adopt the following resolution:

Whereas, the East Hartford Golf Course is a town owned facility providing a great local venue for golfers; and

Whereas, after many years of operating losses, the town leased the golf course and the operations of the golf course and the restaurant to MDM Golf; and

Whereas, MDM Golf has invested a significant amount of money in the golf course but has, of late, failed to maintain the golf course in a condition necessary to attract and retain golfers and has, on several occasions, failed to timely pay the town the quarterly lease payment – though ultimately MDM Golf is current; and

Whereas, it is in the town's best interest to ensure that the golf course and its operations are a source of pride for our community.

Now therefore be it resolved that the East Hartford Town Council supports the Mayor's efforts to invest in the golf course physical plant and would support modifications to the town's contract with MDM Golf consistent with the following principles:

- 1. The town shall set aside any lease income from the golf course for improvements that will enhance the long term operations of the golf course.
- No improvements or town investments shall be made until MDM Golf has submitted an
  independently audited financial statement providing revenue and expense receipts from
  the operations of the golf course and restaurant.
- 3. As a condition of the expenditure of town funds, MDM Golf shall commission a USGA Green Section Turf Advisory Report and commit to making improvements consistent with the report on a timetable approved by the town and to hiring a PGA card carrying golf pro to oversee the operations of the golf course as well as a qualified GCSAA golf course superintendent as required in section 4.20 of the contract. Further MDM Golf shall commit to making any adjustments recommended by a joint town/MDM golf course oversight committee which shall survey the course conditions no less than once every 30 days.
- 4. As a condition of the expenditure of town funds, MDM Golf and the town shall determine the most effective allocation of town resources to improve the restaurant and golf shop facility to increase the rounds of golf, making a priority the elimination of mold in the downstairs area of the building.
- As a condition of the expenditure of town funds, MDM Golf shall maintain a proper number of golf carts.
- As a condition of the expenditure of town funds, MDM Golf shall institute community
  programming to attract individuals to play this course including Golf Course Lessons as
  well as interaction with East Hartford High School Golf teams as well as commencing a
  First Tee Program.
- 7. As a condition of the expenditure of town funds, MDM Golf shall agree to post a bond or line of credit to ensure that the town has adequate financial assurance of continued operation of the golf course in a manner outlined in the lease agreement.

### Commercial property Assessed Clean Energy (C-Pace) Resolution

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE COMMERCIAL PROPERTY ASSESSED CLEAN ENERGY ("C-PACE") AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Section 157 of Public Act No. 12-2 of the June 12, 2012 Special Session of the Connecticut General Assembly (the "Act") established a program, known as the Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy (C-PACE) program, to facilitate loan financing for clean energy improvements to commercial properties by utilizing a state or local assessment mechanism to provide security for repayment of the loans; and

WHEREAS, the Act authorizes the Clean Energy Finance and Investment Authority (the "Authority"), a public instrumentality and political subdivision of the State charged with implementing the C-PACE program on behalf of the State, to enter into a written agreement with participating municipalities pursuant to which the municipality may agree to assess, collect, remit and assign, benefit assessments to the Authority in return for energy improvements for benefited property owners within the municipality and for costs reasonably incurred by the municipality in performing such duties; and

WHEREAS, the Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy ("C-PACE") Agreement (the "C-PACE Agreement") between the Town of East Hartford and the Authority, as attached hereto, constitutes the written agreement authorized by the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:(a) that we, the Town Council, constituting the legislative body of the Town of East Hartford, hereby approves the C-PACE Agreement, and (b) that Mayor Marcia A. Leclerc is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the Town, to execute and deliver the C-PACE Agreement, substantially in the form attached to this Resolution, for the purposes provided therein, together with such other documents as he or she may determine to be necessary and appropriate to evidence, secure and otherwise complete the C-PACE Agreement.



**ELECTION DAY EMERGENCY PROCEDURES** 

Except for loss of power, the following procedures have been in effect for a number of years.

It is important to remember that in the case of emergencies, alarms or disorders the poll workers and the Registrars of Voters are subject to the orders of police, fire or other emergency personnel.

### **BALLOTS**

To determine the number of ballots, including absentee ballots, to be ordered we first consider the voter turnout in past years for like elections. This estimate may be changed for unusual circumstances such as a particularly intense campaign or, in local elections, the presence of questions which engender increased voter attention. We then add 10 per cent to set the total number of ballots ordered.

A small number of ballots are kept in the Registrars' office to be used to photocopy additional ballots should a shortage develop for unanticipated reasons.

### **POLL WORKER SHORTAGE**

A list of trained workers is maintained should a last minute shortage of workers develop due to illness, failure to appear or any other reason. A list of available Moderators is maintained for the same reason.

### MACHINE MALFUNCTIONS

Each polling place has a several backup batteries for the scanners to be used in the event of a power failure. Each polling place also has a backup scanner if the original should malfunction.

### POWER FAILURES AND EMERGENCIES

There are two elements to this section. First, a power or other problem at a single polling place. Second, a town -wide major disaster in which all or multiple polling places are affected.

### PAGE 2

In the first instance each polling place will be assigned to an alternate fully operating polling place. All functions of the affected polling place will be moved to its alternate. The following pairings are in effect:

District 1 Norris School to District 2 Langford School.

District 2 Langford School to District 1 Norris School.

District 3 Mayberry School to District 2 Langford School.

District 4 Silver Lane School to District 5 Hockanum School

District 5 Hockanum School to District 4 Silver Lane School

District 6 Goodwin School to District 7 St. Christopher's Hall

District 7 St. Christopher's Hall to District 6 Goodwin School.

In the second instance (town wide failures) polling places will be moved to buildings which have generators for power. These sites are Town Hall, the Public Safety Complex and the High School. There will be more than one polling place at each emergency location. Voting Districts 1, 2 and 3 will be moved to the Public Safety Complex. Voting Districts 4 and 5 will be moved to Town Hall. Districts 6 and 7 will be moved to the High School.

Information spelling out these changes will be disseminated through TV and radio stations and posting on the town's web site.

When these proposals are finalized we will post a sign at each polling place in every election or primary advising voters where they should go in each instance. If possible to do safely a staff member will be posted at each affected polling place to provide real time information to voters.

### DISORDER IN THE POLLING PLACE

In the event of a disorder that cannot be quickly resolved by the Moderator the Moderator is instructed to dial 911 for assistance, then call the Registrars. In no case should the Moderator or any other worker take any action that could place them in danger. Wait for police or fire personnel.

### **ALARMS**

First, in any alarm situation the poll workers and Registrars will be subject to the control of emergency personnel (police and fire).

If a fire or other alarm is sounded the Moderators are instructed to see to the safety of voters and poll workers first.

### PAGE 3

If possible to do without danger to personnel and only with the approval of first responders, poll workers are to safeguard and remove critical polling equipment and records. The Tabulator Tender should attempt to roll the tabulator out of the polling place or remove and carry out the scanner. The Ballot Clerk should attempt to bring outside all unused ballots. Checkers should bring their official lists with them. The Moderator and Assistant Registrars should safeguard or bring out with them all important materials in their areas.

None of these actions are to be taken if they pose the slightest danger to personnel.

GRANT BARNES SCHOOL ASBESTOS FLOOR TILE REMOVAL

I wish to inform you that the Board of Education approved the referenced project with the understanding that funding would come from the BOE Capital Reserve account.

As this project is a code and health category, it is eligible for reimbursement under the State School Construction grant regulations in the amount of 72% reimbursement. In order to be eligible under the grant guidelines, the Board and the Town Council must take certain action which by way of this memo I am requesting.

The following criteria is required to complete a school construction grant application.

- 1. Town Council resolutions as follows:
  - a. The Council shall authorize the Board to apply for the grant; and
  - The Council shall approve the Board to utilize the funds in the BOE Capital Reserve account for this project which shall serve as the local share of construction costs; and
  - c. The Council shall refer the project to the Public Building Commission; and
  - d. The Council shall authorize at least the preparation of schematic drawings and specifications to begin.

Attached you will find a report from Mr. Costa, our Director of Facilities, which will explain the project in detail.

In closing, the Board has asked me to respectfully request your support and the Council's support for this project. Once the resolutions have been authorized, we will submit the required State Grant application to the Department of Education.

It is our hope that this item can be placed on the April 2, 2013 Town Council Agenda. Mr. Costa will be available to attend that meeting. If you have any questions please feel free to contact me.

### Asbestos Abatement Barnes Elementary School

### 1. **PROJECT RATIONALE**

The original school building was constructed in 1957 with one addition in 1965. Currently the academic wing of the building contains 29,300 square feet of floor area consisting of vinyl asbestos floor tile with asbestos mastic. TRC Environmental is the district's environmental consultant. The asbestos containing building materials have been inspected and tested in accordance to the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (USEPA) and State of Connecticut Department of Public Health (CTDPH) requirements for asbestos in schools.

After more than 50 years, the existing floors, which are asbestos, have reached a point where it is no longer possible to maintain or perform small repairs. The floors have well exceeded their useful life.

The proposed asbestos abatement project will be designed by a CT Licensed Asbestos consultant, once funding is in place. The design will conform to the USEPA and CTDPH standards and abatement will not be performed when school is in session. Design will also include the installation of Vinyl Composite Tile (VCT) once the abatement phase is completed. Design for abatement will include approximately 17 rooms totaling about 15,000 square feet.

### 2. LONG-RANGE PLAN

The long-range plan for the school incorporates provisions for a safe and appropriate learning environment. This project will ensure the safety and health of the students and staff. The district plans to continue to utilize the Barnes Elementary School in its current capacity for the next twenty years and beyond.





Attached please find the parade permit application for the Town of East Hartford Patriotic Commission, which seeks a permit to conduct the Town's annual Memorial Day Parade on Monday, May 27, 2013, from 9:30 AM to approximately 12:00 noon. The permit is sought in accordance with Town Ordinance TO 5-1(b).

Town Ordinance 5-5(a) requires that a certificate of insurance must accompany an application for a parade permit. As a Town commission, the proposed parade would be covered by the Town's insurance. A memorandum from Cindy Bennett, Risk Manager, regarding this coverage is attached.

Pursuant to Town Ordinance (TO) 5-3, a review of the application was completed by the Directors of the Police, Fire, Parks and Recreation, Health and Public Works Departments. Their comments are as follows:

The Fire, Health and Parks & Recreation Departments approve the application as submitted.

The **Public Works Department** reviewed the application and recommends that the application be approved subject to the following conditions:

- The applicant shall obtain a highway use permit from the DOT District 1 Office for the closure and detour of Burnside Avenue (Rte. 44).
- The applicant shall coordinate the placement of barricades and signs with the Department of Public Works.
- Anticipated cost to Public Works for this event is \$5,000.00.

The **Police Department** can supply adequate police protection for the conduct of this activity and offers the following comments:

 The proposed route requires the establishment of two (2) complex detour routes. This will require employing approximately thirty-five (35) Police Officers to establish and maintain the parade route and traffic detours. The majority of these Officers will be provided through overtime hiring.

Anticipated cost to the Department for this event is \$12,000.00.

- The applicant has made or will make application to the State Traffic Commission for the necessary road closure permit for Route 44 (Burnside Avenue) and to the Town's Director of Public Works for Hillside Street. It is anticipated that these permits will be approved.
- The necessary prohibition of all vehicles on the parade route (Burnside Avenue between Long Hill and Hillside Streets and between Hillside and Roberts Streets]) will severely disrupt the traffic flow in the vicinity. This prohibition is anticipated to be for a period of approximately 3.5 hours. Alternative routes to most intersecting streets are available. It should be noted that during the road closure period, vehicles will not be allowed to exit or enter onto Burnside Avenue from the following streets:

Bidwell Street Church Street Elmer Street Francis Street Hanmer Street Howard Court Larrabee Street Moore Avenue Price Court School Street Scotland Road Terry Street Williams Street Wind Road

- The posting of temporary NO PARKING signs and the placement of temporary traffic barricades and over numerous detour signs will be accomplished by the Public Works Department. These signs and barricades facilitate the closing of the parade route. Because of the complexity and scope of this task, it will be necessary to establish early detours, and close the parade route to vehicles well in advance of the actual parade obstruction.
- During the parade, access to the area for emergency vehicles will continue to be provided. Police personnel equipped with two-way radios are stationed along the parade route at strategic locations. Should access by emergency vehicles be necessary, the parade is halted, and marking units shifted to one side of the street, thereby allowing for the safe passage of emergency vehicles and personnel.
- No vehicles will be permitted inside Hillside Cemetery. It will be necessary for parade route vehicles to be parked on side streets in the area of Roberts Street.

It is recommended that the Council require the applicant to conduct an aggressive public information program well in advance of the parade, to inform the public of the closures and detours.
