If the Commission feels that they need more time to review the Charter, the financial section in particular, it would be the decision of the Commission. She is agreeable with the decision of having a Town Administrator and believes it would be beneficial for the town. She suggested having more public events to discuss the proposed changes at civic organizations and the Senior Center.
