Chief DeMarco explained there was a high failure rate (cyclical) for the written and physical exams, but they do have several candidates that are moving on to the next selection process. They will be doing background checks and then scheduling meetings with the administrative side and police commission in the next few weeks. Chairman Stremper asked if we have a test company for the test. Chief DeMarco explained that is costly so we purchase exams from a national company and run it using our departmental staff.

Ms. Nelson stated the budget failed the final referendum which will result in a 2% increase by Charter. A lengthy discussion occurred regarding the application of the 2%.
