6. TRAFFIC AUTHORITY:

Chief DeMarco stated the traffic calming measures have encumbered approximately \$65,000 of the \$70,000 grant for updating the signs throughout the town and for traffic measures used to slow and stop drivers. Commissioner Long questioned if the drop-off issues at the school have improved. Chief DeMarco explained we are off to a good start according to the Superintendent. Commissioner Long also questioned why cars will always catch a red light at Main if they had a red light at Rt. 5 and Newberry. Chief DeMarco explained the Department of Transportation's engineers did a study and has optimally timed the lights for traffic purposes.

7. NEW BUSINESS:

Commissioner Filipone asked how East Windsor was doing in relation to crime. Chief DeMarco explained crime is down nationally and locally in East Windsor it is down 25-28%. The only exception is the crime of larceny. Commissioner Long asked how many car cameras the police department was getting. Chief DeMarco explained we are getting four cameras for frontline patrol cars. Commissioner Long also asked if we would get a discount if we purchased two more now. Chief DeMarco explained there would be no cost savings. Chief DeMarco also explained we will be applying for grant money for body cameras at some time in the future. Commissioner Filipone asked what types of vehicles were ordered. Chief DeMarco explained the police department ordered two sedans and one SUV Interceptor (all of which are all-wheel drive).
