7. **New Application:**
 - A. **Application of Hull Forest Products, LLC, 45 Champion Hill Road, Timber Harvest, planned harvest and removal of timber products – M12/B40A/L20B**
Chris Casadei, Forester for Hull was before the agency and explained it is a flat terrain and was logged in the early 1990's. They are going to use the existing skid trails, with one small crossing to accesses about 12 trees. They will use a temporary bridge for the crossing.

 - B. **Application of Peter Marlowe Forest Products LLC, Hog Hill & Pine Brook Road, Markham Timber Harvest – Map 14/Block 31A/Lot 12, Map 14/Block 31/Lot 4B, Map 7/Block 23/Lot 1 & Map 13/block 22/Lot 4**
The applicant was not present for the meeting. There was a brief discussion of the location of this logging. Mr. Hayden was asked by the agency to confirm owner and location of this property and if it should be one application or two? Mr. Hayden stated this is one activity therefore only in need of one application.
