8. <u>Continued Applications</u>:

A. Applicant for The Town of East Hampton, 28 Oak Knoll Road, catch basin/stream channel armoring. M01A/B47/LC-9

Mr. Hayden described this project as a result of negotiations of attorneys and the property owner in addition to the owner of the car wash in the rear. The property owners property was damaged when the catch basin plugged up and his basement flooded. There is some direct wetland impact, approximately 600SF, with approximately 1800SF of upland impact. This work would be completed by a contractor hired by the town. Without rain fall, the ditch is dry and any work would be planned during a no rain forecast. It would take about 4 days total for the work to be completed.

Mr. Wilson moved, and Mr. Boule seconded approve the Applicant for The Town of East Hampton, 28 Oak Knoll Road, catch basin/stream channel armoring M01A/B47/LC-9, with conditions. The motion carried unanimously.

The updated wetland maps will be comprised of 73 digital maps, one town wide index plan and 72 smaller scale plans showing wetland soils overlaid on the assessor's property parcel maps. Converting the wetland maps to a digital format will enable the Town to update the maps annually to include wetland delineations submitted as part of permit applications. The digital maps will be posted on the Town's website providing residents better access to the mapping. The agency would like to thank Josh and Emily Wilson for all of their hard work.
