In accordance with Sections C6-5, and C6-2 (3) of the Town of Eastham Home Rule Charter, the Board of Selectmen and the Finance Committee will hold a public hearing on **Monday, April 14, 2014, at 5:00PM** at the Eastham Town Hall, in the Earle Mountain Room, 2500 State Highway, Eastham, MA 02642 on the Proposed FY16-20 Five Year Capital Improvement Plan and FY15 Operating Budget. The capital plan, covering all departments and the Eastham Elementary School includes vehicles, technology replacements and improvements to municipal buildings. Major additions this year include road drainage improvements of \$80,000 and road surface work of \$200,000. All amounts and items shown in said capital improvement plan are estimates and are subject to review, refinement, additions and deletions at each Annual Town Meeting where the plan is authorized. Copies of the proposed plan and budget are available for inspection at the Eastham Town Hall in the Town Administrator's Office, Monday-Friday, 8:00AM to 4:00PM and on the Town website at www.eastham-ma.gov.
