I. CALL TO ORDER

II. Cemetery Trustee:

III. Church Exemptions:

V. George Hill Road:

The Board discussed the potential removal of large stones/boulders located within the Town's right-of-way. The Board would like the work to wait until after the next Selectmen's meeting to begin that work, they would like to have an opportunity to visit George Hill Road and inspect the stones/boulders.

VI. Vehicle Use Policy:

Schneider updated the Board on the question of creating a waiver for non-town personnel traveling in a Town vehicle. It was the opinion of the Town Attorney that no waiver could be created that would protect the Town against a potential lawsuit. The new policy will specifically prohibit any non-Town personnel traveling in a Town vehicle.
