

Cemetery Trustee Minutes  
Oct.27,2010

A meeting of the Cemetery Trustees was held at the home of Fred Altvater at 7 P.M.

Attending were, Fred Altvater Chairman, Richard Henderson and David Stewart Trustees. William Shoemaker, Sexton and Derek Corbin, Sexton's assistant.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Cemetery Budget for the coming year of 2011.

The first and primary item was the purchase of a new mowing machine as selected by William Shoemaker our Sexton who is in charge of the mowing of all of our cemeteries.

The machine selected is an X-Mark at a cost of \$8,200 with allowance of \$4000 trade in for a total expense of \$4,200. This item has the approval of all three Trustees.

Stainless Steel cemetery lot markers to be laid out by Chris Rollins, Surveyor at a cost of \$560. Markers will be installed under the direction of the Sexton and will be flush at ground level. These markers will eliminate the need of granite corner markers at each lot and will eliminate any problems when mowing is required. The requirement for individual lot markers will be eliminated from the Rules & Regulations concerning Enfield Cemeteries under the jurisdiction of the Enfield Cemetery Trustees.

A flagpole to be purchased and erected and having a U.S. Flag at the top. This will be illuminated with a solar powered lighting system. Estimated cost is \$1000.

Landscaping will also begin in 2011 and shall progress until completed on a yearly basis. Estimated cost for small shrubs and other plantings for 2011 shall be \$1000.

To keep costs at a minimum the work will be accomplished by the Sexton and his assistant.
