TREASURER'S REPORT: Gary Gaudette reported +/- \$11,000 in the Conservation Fund.

PUBLIC FORUM:

Erland Schulson was in attendance to discuss his Permit by Notification to replace the retaining wall on his property located on Lake Street. He and Don Roberts explained how this was going to be done. The consensus of the Commission was that this acceptable and the use of the existing stones on the property was the way to go. It was stated that any permit to replace retaining walls made of wooden, treated ties with stone or concrete should be welcomed and approved immediately. The Town has several of these tie walls around the beach and boat launch area that should be replaced. Shirley Green made a motion to sign the permit as presented, Fred Paradis seconded, all vote in favor.
