We discussed buying a small hydroturbine for a project on the river that could get Enfield going towards generating some of its own electricity. Or perhaps a wooden water wheel to incorporate the historic aspect. Maybe this could power some bridge lights. We discussed buying some more demonstration LEDs for other buildings such as Whitney Hall. Or a wooden mill wheel? It was decided that this project doesn't have enough of a plan to justify \$1000 on equipment at this point.

Budget decisions:

Rich moved motion that we use up to \$500 for more LED demonstration products (and installation) with this year's budget. APPROVED.

Steve moved that we use up to \$400 to get a motion sensor and/or appropriate light switch for the DPW, (includes installation). APPROVED.

Rich moved that we use up to \$200 to purchase some books and/or periodicals on green energy and renewables for the library. Perhaps Home Power as a periodical. Rich will talk with Marge about space and how to purchase. APPROVED.
