

MAY 24, 2012 MINUTES

ENFIELD HERITAGE COMMISSION

The May meeting of the Enfield Heritage Commission was held in the Whitney Hall Conference Room on May 24, 2012. Those in attendance: Mary Ann Haagen, Celie Aufiero, Marjorie Carr, Suzanne Hinman, Steve Schneider, Town Manager, and Meredith Smith, Chair.

A discussion of the email from Elizabeth Muzzey (Director of NH Historic Resources) regarding the proposed historic marker resulted in a lengthy discussion. Mary Ann Haagen will also supply additional documentation regarding Caleb Dyer's involvement with Enfield Village.

Meredith Smith reported on the activities of the Bridge Opening Committee. There were suggestions for educational programs for EVS and possibly the high school. These suggestions will be discussed at the next Bridge Opening Committee meeting.

Enfield Center Town House: Meredith reported that Dave's Glass Barn has not firmed up a quote to repair the windows yet.

Meredith Smith reported that Jim Garvin had done a full architectural inspection of the Greeley House for EVA and a report from Mr. Garvin will be forthcoming.

Steve Schneider reported on the bridge lighting project. Lights for the bridge have been cut back to four and will comply with lighting ordinances.
