ENFIELD HERITAGE COMMISSION

Those in attendance: Suzanne Hinman, Celie Aufiero, Rebecca Stewart, Meredith Smith.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The approval of the August minutes was held over till next month; only Celie was here for August meeting.

HISTORIC MARKER PROJECT: Suzanne updated the Commission on the wording for the marker. She has added the phrase 'across Mascoma Lake'. Suzanne asked about funding. Meredith suggested she contact Steve Schneider and request town funding. Suzanne also asked about placement (where to put the sign). MCS suggested having two choices to present to the State.
