Enfield Shaker Scenic Byway Update

A meeting of the Enfield Shaker Scenic Byway was held on January 24, 2017. Three members of the Heritage Commission are also members of the Byway Advisory Board. They are Marjorie Carr, Mary Ann Haagen, and Meredith Smith. Meredith was elected chair of the Advisory Board with Mary Ann Haagen as Vice Chair. The Advisory Board has one year from January 2017 to comply with the requirements of NH DOT for designation as a Scenic Byway to with the State. Presently, the Shaker Scenic Byway is on the list to be de-designated as a scenic byway due to lack of active participation. The Advisory Board is the first step in getting te byway back in good standing. Work will begin immediately on this project.

Enfield Shaker Museum Update

Shirley Green, Enfield Shaker Museum Board member, informed the Commission of the up-coming Snowshoe Fest, to be held at the Museum on Saturday, January 28.
