The Treasurer explained that \$50 was deposited into savings from the checking account to keep the account active.

Two gifts have been received totally \$175.00 have been received. One gift was given to the library in memory of Nellie Beaupre and one gift was from the PTA.

There was a strong library presence in the July 4th parade, as part of the town's 250th celebration. Trustees Shirley and Francine held the banner followed by Mrs. Carr riding in the convertible with the giant Cat in the Hat, and a number of adults and children dressed in costume. Also, in conjunction with the 250th, there was a display of old books, some dating back to 100 years, in the library.

The library is preparing for the annual book sale. Set up will be this week and the sale will start on Saturday. There are a number of helpers lined up to sort and set up the books.

Many readers are signed up for the summer reading program. There are currently three different storytimes —two for the summer recreation program and older children and one for preschoolers. Steve Blunt will perform on July 29th as part of the summer program.

Mrs. Carr reported that inter-library loans use is up with both books coming in and going out of the library.

The circulation count for June was 3286 and 235 people used the public computers and wireless connection. The story time attendance for the month of June was 76.
