MINUTES of May 15, 2013

OLD HOME DAY COMMITTEE

A meeting of the Old Home day committee was held at the Enfield Shaker Museum on May 15. Those in attendance were: Dolores Struckhoff, Lori Bliss, Marge Carr, Marge Hudge, Shirley Green, and Meredith Smith.

Dolores mentioned that the Lions have a tent that the library might want to use for activities planned for the parking lot. Shirley also mentioned that they had planned to have free ice cream as part of their celebration. Meredith will report this to EVA, since they had mentioned the possibility of doing an ice cream social. Shirley also reported that the Conservation Commission would like to sponsor a hike as part of the festivities.

Shirley Green agreed to contact businesses and individuals for listings in the Program of Events. Each listing will cost \$10 and will help to defray any expenses incurred (publicity and other small expenses). Shirley began her fund raising at the meeting by collecting \$10 from several members of the committee for postings in the program.

Meredith reported that she had sent an article to the Mascoma Lake Association for their newsletter. Dolores & Shirley both asked her to send it to them as well for posting in the Crystal Lake newsletter and the Museum e news.

The committee agreed to meet every 2 weeks for the foreseeable future. The next meeting will be May 29 at 5:30 PM (NOTE NEW TIME).
