1. Regional Recreation Director - Steve

Enfield Select Board expressed concern that communities fund recreation very differently. Canaan uses user fees, not tax support as Enfield. Enfield Selectboard reluctant to put in any additional money at this point. Selectboard did not want to subsidize other towns. Selectboard is cautious about the position due to the difference in funding. Currently grants have been obtained \$18-20k to support the position.

What will new position do? Work with MYSL to hopefully get them to buy into the towns, through Regional Rec director, having a central role and guidance. Provide office support for MYSL. Develop other recreation programs for kids not just ages 5-12. Expand opportunities for young adults and adults.

This person needs to work on expanding what recreation means.

Some ideas from Cindy Heath (UV Heal)

Stay focused on these activities: Sports (competitive/recreation), Arts (writing/music/theatre/visual arts), outdoor adventure, community events. Work on keeping them balanced and different age levels.

Also "Play! Mascoma Valley" development and publication.

Next steps, review candidates and hire and finalize understanding.

Possible joint rec commission meetings, Canaan & Enfield.
