The Commission continued a Public Hearing on a Notice of Intent filed by Robert Kaminski for work previously conducted without a permit with the 100' buffer zone to onsite resource areas as well as additional proposed site work, including restoration activities at 109 Eastern Avenue. The final plan was submitted which included the requested revisions from the previous meeting. Mr. Young advised that the applicant had approved the timeline and the fence and trees would be in place by the end of October.
