The Chairman opened the meeting for regular business. The Agent reported that he had been to 10 Patriots Lane and there had been some damage from hurricane Irene. DeRosa Environmental is aware of the situation and will repair and/or replace the damaged plants. It was also noted that the cross boards from the boardwalk have been removed and DeRosa Environmental will also monitor the growth in this area.

The Clerk presented a Certificate for Compliance for 19 Lufkin Point Road. She explained that the Certificate was needed to clear up a clerical error regarding DEP filing numbers and the chain of title for the property. The Commission agreed to issue the Certificate to remedy the mistake and clear the chain of title. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to issue the Certificate of Compliance for 19 Lufkin Point Road.
