The Commission opened a public hearing on a Notice of Intent filed by Neil and Susan Shoriskey to install an in-ground pool at 1 Riverview Hill. The Commission discussed the location of the project and the best way to contain erosion and debris. It was determined that the project would have no significant impact once completed. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to close the public hearing. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to issue an Order of Conditions with the conditions that hay bales and silt fencing be installed on the downward side of the project within the contained area and that the erosion control must be maintained over the winter.

The Commission reviewed changes submitted for a Conservation Restriction which had already been approved at 90 Apple Street. The changes had been requested by the EOEEA and where technical changes. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to accept the changes and resign the Conservation Restriction.

The Commission discussed the problem of winter storage on the marsh. The Commission determined that it would have the Clerk draft two letters regarding storage, one to the houseboat owner storing a houseboat at Conomo Point and a general letter to residents regarding storage guidelines. This matter was tabled to a future meeting.

The Chairman presented the minutes from the meeting of October 3, 2015 for approval. On a motion made and duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to accept the minutes as presented.

On a motion made and duly seconded, the meeting was adjourned.
